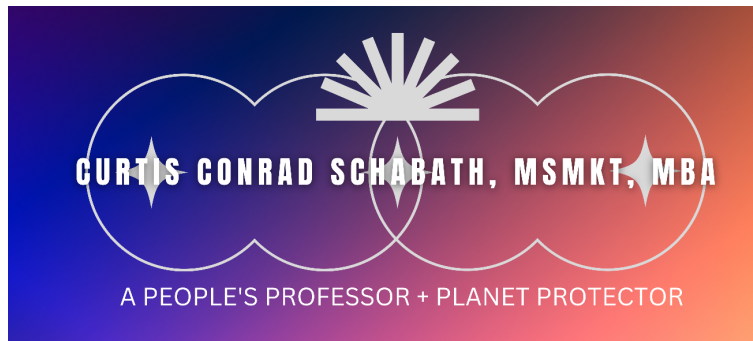




Greetings!
